

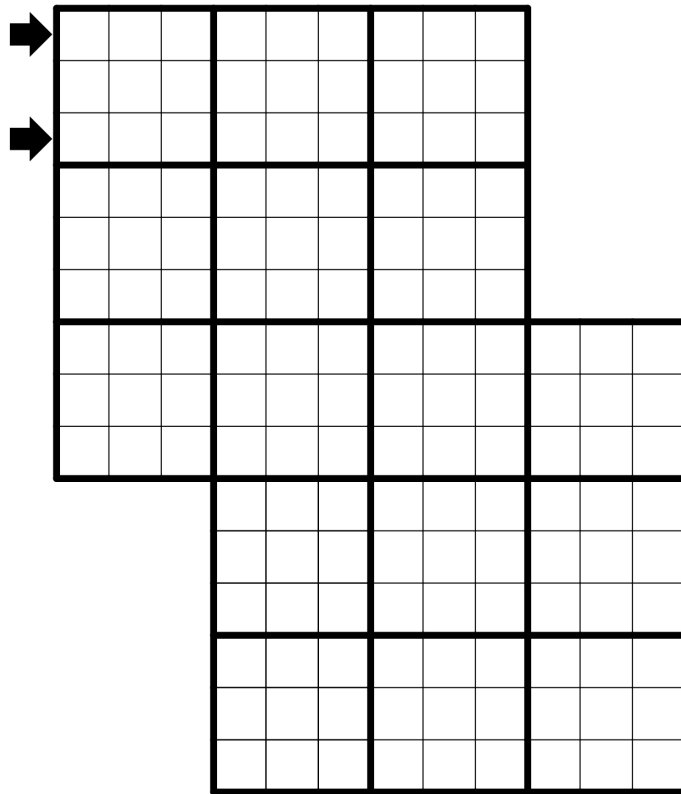


Blank Format For AISC Round 3

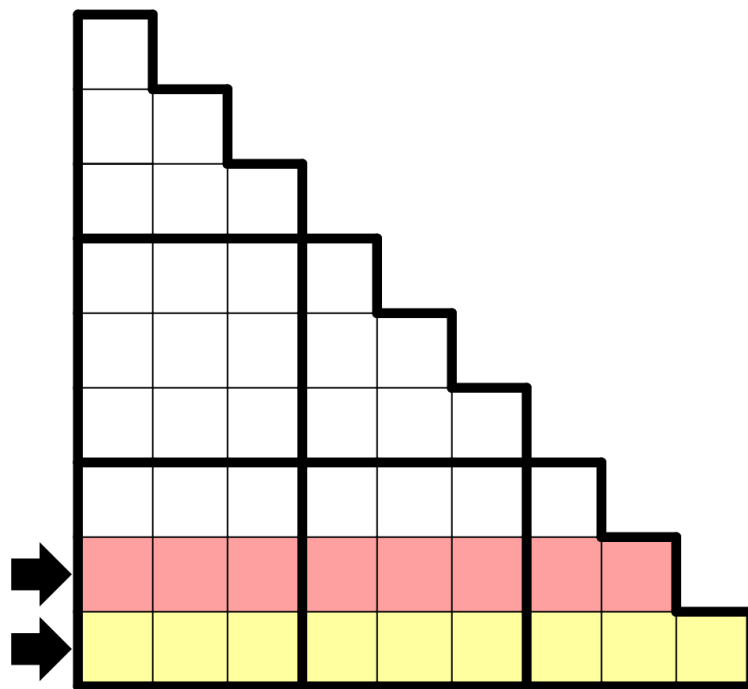
Rules:

1. **Twodoku** consists of two grids 9×9 . The numbers must be placed correctly for both puzzle squares.
2. **Sujiken** (from Japanese "sujikai", literally "diagonal") is a variation of **Sudoku**, invented by **George Heineman (USA)**. The puzzle consists of a triangular grid of cells containing digits from 1 to 9. The objective is to fill a grid with digits so that each cell contains a digit and no digit is repeated in any column, row and diagonal in any direction. Also, no digit occurs twice in any of the three larger 3×3 square regions and any of the three larger triangular regions enclosed by thick borders.
3. **Little Unique Killer Sudoku** is a variation of **Little Killer Sudoku**. Clues outside the grid indicate the sums of digits in the direction of the corresponding arrow. Digits may not repeat within a sum.
4. **Note the answer key, all digits in highlighted cell without space, left to right.**
5. **Submit the answer key at form.**
